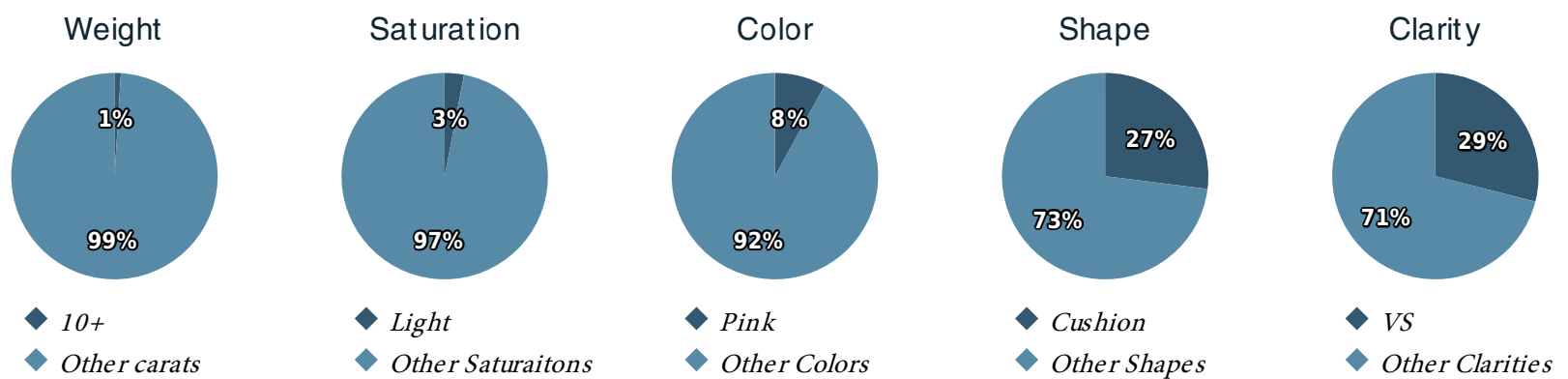

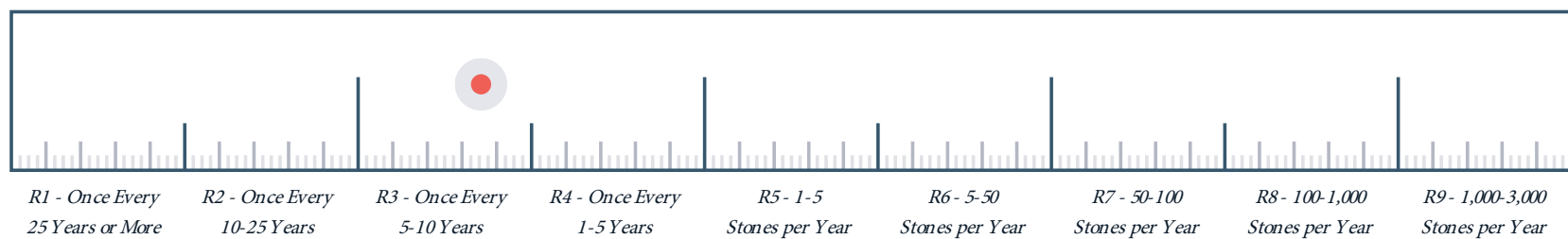

The rarity report analyzes rarity out of approximately 60,000 stones that are submitted to the GIA every year.

Diamond Rarity Scale



● Once every 8-10 years

General

Only 3% of all diamonds above 1 carat submitted to grading labs are classified as fancy color. Pink diamonds represent only 8.2% of all fancy color diamonds. The cause of pink color is believed to be a result of plastic deformation in the diamond's structure; as opposed to other colored diamonds, it is not due to foreign elements trapped in the crystal.
